International relations – opening the world

We focus on building and broadening our present range of partnerships with European and overseas universities. Our aim is to create a basis for teaching- and study exchange programmes, internships and research. Beyond the regular exchange programmes, we also cooperate with our partners by sharing innovative teaching methods.



Academic excellence

The Faculty of Business and Economics is an international centre of academic excellence. The members of the teaching staff have both practical experience and highly specialised knowledge in their respective research fields. The Hungarian degree is issued by our School, based on the licence received from the Hungarian Accreditation Committee.

Areas of Research

- For successfully completing PhD studies, it is crucial to decide on the topic of dissertation on time and to select the most appropriate supervisor. Some Professors provide topics and supervision in German. In this case the dissertation must be written in German.
- Therefore, we advise you to familiarise yourself with the research activity of the Faculty staff in order to find a professor who has a research interest that relates to your proposed topic. The research topics are only recommendations; however, they show the research interests and culture of the University of Pécs Faculty of Business and Economics.

Vibrant student life



Application process



International applicants use the School's online application platform (<https://apply.pte.hu/>), through which the application process is the following:

1. The applicant uploads all the required documents on the online application platform:
 - ✓ a copy of valid passport;
 - ✓ a super-legalised copy of the certificate of school leaving examination;
 - ✓ a super-legalised copy of the Transcript of Studies (e.g.: grade report);
 - ✓ a copy of a CEFR B2 level language exam certificate (not older than 2 years) of an internationally recognised language exam;
 - ✓ a copy of a medical certificate in English language that states that the applicant is fit for studies in higher education
 - ✓ a copy of the immunisation card and their English language translation;
 - ✓ a CV and a motivation letter; and other certificates or references.



2. After submitting the documents, applicant receives an official invoice of the application fee;



3. after the payment of the application fee, the uploaded materials are evaluated and a decision is made whether the applicant is eligible or not;



4. an oral interview (personal or online) is scheduled with eligible applicants and carried out by a committee;



5. based on the applicant's academic qualification, motivation letter and the oral interview a decision is made on acceptance;



6. selected applicants receive an offer invoice of the first semester's tuition fee;



7. accepted students receive their official Letter of Acceptance after paying the tuition fee for the first semester of their studies.



About the decision

The decision on acceptance is based on an evaluation system of 100 points, which was introduced, in order to provide a clear standard of entry criteria.


Pécs

The time you are going to spend as a university student will be the best part of your life, especially if you spend it in such a vibrating city as Pécs. Our city is a beautiful place to study. Not only because it is simultaneously a friendly town and a very active city, in which you never have to be bored. You can be sure you will find everything that a student could wish for.

Winning the “European Capital of Culture 2010” award wasn’t a matter of luck for the city which sneaks up to the hills of Mecsek. Pécs is truly a city of culture with its two-thousand-year-long history. In addition, all the sights can be reached from the centre by a nice walk – or by the Dotto, the local mini-train.

Because of the unique locality of Pécs, you simply cannot get lost in the city. If you go down from the hill soon you will find yourself in the city centre. But if you are willing to spend some time in the untroubled nature, all you have to do is to go up the hill.

The Mecsek hill surrounding Pécs is a harmonic place to visit during the whole year. On the top of it you will find the TV-tower, with a restaurant and an amazing view of the city. If you don’t mind taking a bus or a bike, Lake Malomvölgy or Lake Orfű are the best places to visit to be near the water, especially in summertime.





Hungary

Hungary is a beautiful landlocked EU-country situated in the middle of the continent. Despite being rather small, its beneficial Central European position makes the country an attractive destination to live, work or study. Hungary has much to offer for visitors, from the architectural and cultural delights of historic cities, to vineyard-covered hills, freshwater lakes and therapeutic mineral spas. This small country is one of the oldest in Europe where 2000-year-old Roman ruins and 400-year-old Turkish monuments can be found side by side.

Hungarian higher education has represented academic excellence for more than 600 years. The country's first university was founded in Pécs in 1367, around the same time as other Central European universities, such as those in Prague, Cracow and Vienna.
