<b>Specification of the quality objective:</b> In the 2019/2020 academic year, an increase in the acceptance proportion of subjects that students accomplish abroad.

<b>Quality objective 3: Launch of infrastructure development at the Faculty</b>	
<b>Background of setting the quality objective:</b> From the resources formerly allocated by the Modern Cities Programme to the Faculty but not used for the original purpose (University Business Centre), the management of the Faculty prepared settlement infrastructure developments. The most significant of these is the reconstruction of the air conditioning system, the special importance of which is stressed, among other things, by the international accreditation. Due to the repeated problems in the planning and public procurement process, the project is significantly delayed and has not started yet.	
<b>Specification of the quality objective:</b> Launch of the reconstruction of the air conditioning system as an infrastructure development project of the Faculty.
