

COMPULSORY INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE

FOR STUDENTS

AT THE BSC BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION AND

MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME

Pécs, 2024

The purpose of the proposal:

This regulation is designed to officially motivate and encourage BSc BAM students to engage in international programs, including both student mobility and Internationalization at Home activities.

Each student is required to accumulate 20 international points over the course of the 7-semester program, which will be recognized as an international experience.

The framework for implementation:**OPTION 1:**

- study or work placement mobility abroad (full semester),
- participation in a double degree programme (two semesters),

OPTION 2:

- participation in internationalisation activities available at the school (Internationalization at Home – i@home activities).

OPTION 1: Mobility

- Physical mobility is the preferred option.
- Students participating in the Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship programme are encouraged to gain experience in accordance with the relevant legal conditions; physical mobility is currently not supported.

Mobility duration: at least one semester (5 months)

International points for mobility: 20

Recommended semesters for mobility: semesters 3-6

Mobility conditions:

- Students must apply for an Erasmus+/Pannónia scholarship according to those regulations.
- If the student is not eligible for an Erasmus+/Pannónia scholarship, s/he must participate in i@home activities available at the school and accumulate the necessary credits from those.

OPTION 2: Participation in School i@home activities

Requirement: 20 international points (1 point = at least 5 contact hours)

Activities	Duration	International points
iExpo participation as exhibitor	1 day	1
Conference presentation in English	1 occasion	1
International Video Pitch Competition + report	2 round at least	1
Summer School (abroad, at partner institution)	1 week at least	depending on the length of the courses*
Participation in A or B courses implemented in international cooperation	Semester	depending on the type of the international cooperation (max 10)*
Participation in C courses implemented in international cooperation	Semester	depending on the type of the international cooperation (max 5)*
International Teaching Week or World of Practice guest lectures	4 occasions	1
Work in International Student Organizations	At least one semester	1-5*
Internship (in English not in the home country)	12 weeks	20

*The Programme Director decides on the international points.

I@home projects not listed above might be subjects of the Programme Director's decision based on the details and length of the project.

Non-compliance

The student is not allowed to participate in the Defence (Final Examination) without gathering the necessary 20 international points. After the seventh semester, only internship (work experience) can be accounted for the missing international points.

Recording of CIX points:

CIX points are recorded in the official NEPTUN system, and students can review their points at the end of each semester.

Entry into force:

According to the decision of the Faculty Council, Compulsory International Experience (collection of at least 20 international points) applies to students starting at September 2021 or later.
