Level of studies	(Finnish) Bachelor level (210-240 ECTS), yet we welcome both Bachelor and Master level exchange students to our courses and projects.
Language of instruction	English, (Finnish)
Finnish language course	An elementary course is available for all exchange students free of charge. Note, many Finns speak English as foreign language.
Semester dates	Academic year: from the autumn semester till the spring semester <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Autumn semester: from the last week of August till approx. the middle of December • Spring semester: from the beginning of January till the end of April/middle of May Note: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the beginning and the end dates may vary depending on each course • there is no separate exam period, exams are included in the semester dates • obligatory orientation days during the first week of the semester
Credit system	One ECTS credit equals 27 hours of student work. 60 ECTS credits equal one academic year of study.

Grading system	The grading scale at TUAS: 5=excellent, 4=good, 3=good, 2=satisfactory, 1=satisfactory, H = passed, 0 = failed
Tuition Fees	There are no tuition fees for the exchange students coming from TUAS partner institutions.

Nomination deadline	<p>The home institution should nominate their student applicants to the host campus staff by e-mail before the application period ends.</p> <p>The needed information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • student's name and e-mail address • study program / field at the home institution • study program / field at TUAS • duration of exchange (autumn/spring semester or whole academic year)
Requirements	TUAS does not require an English Language Proficiency test from the students. However, the students should at least meet the following requirements: English language proficiency of minimum TOEFL 550, IELTS 6 or equivalent, CGPA of 2.5 and above.
Approval	TUAS reserves the right to approve or to reject the applicant. TUAS will e-mail confirmation and further instructions to the student.
