

Call for Applications – Demonstrator Scholarship

for the Second Semester of the 2025/2026 Academic Year
 Faculty of Business and Economics, University of Pécs

The Faculty of Business and Economics of the University of Pécs (hereinafter: **FBE, UP**) invites applications for a **Demonstrator Scholarship** at the **Department of Management Science** for the second semester of the 2025/2026 academic year, with the aim of **supporting students' academic progress and reducing dropout rates**.

Eligibility

The scholarship can be awarded to only one student.

Applications are open to students who:

- hold an active student status in one of the **Master Programme** in English at FBE, UP,
- have successfully completed the **Business Intelligence module** with an **excellent (5)** grade and ranked in the **top 10 percent of their cohort** based on their **grade point average**,
- are capable and highly motivated to **undertake tutorial activities in Business Intelligence**, i.e., holding extra classes for fellow students during the semester under the coordination of the module instructors.

Preference will be given to applicants who can also contribute with **research assistance** related to the department's profile.

Application Procedure

Applicants must complete the official application form and submit it in one of the following ways:

- **in person:** at the Study Department of FBE, UP.

Scholarship Amount

The amount of the scholarship is **HUF 300,000**.

The scholarship will be transferred in a lump sum at the end of the semester in accordance with the **Reimbursement and Benefit Regulations (TJSZ)**.

Deadline

Applications must be submitted by **February 6, 2026**.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Evaluation and Results

The evaluation will be based on the **ranking of the applicants** according to **two main criteria**:

- the **performance** achieved in the **Business Intelligence course**,
- their position in the ranking within their cohort based on **grade point average**.

In the case of a tie, the decision will be made based on the percentage performance achieved in Business Intelligence and by considering any research assistance provided to the Department.

The applications will be evaluated by a committee, which consists of the head of the Department of Management Science, the instructors of the Business Intelligence course, and one student member.

Applicants will be notified of the outcome via their **Neptun e-mail address** within **3 working days** after the decision.

If, for any reason, a student's enrolment status becomes inactive or is terminated after the beginning of the semester, they shall lose their eligibility for the scholarship, and their place may be taken by the next student in the evaluation ranking.

An appeal may be lodged against the decision made in the course of the application procedure within fifteen days from the date of notification, or, in the absence thereof, from the date on which the applicant becomes aware of it. The appeal shall be decided by the Committee of Academic Appeals.
