



Procedure of the New Type of Final Examination

Students may apply for the final examination if their thesis supervisor has deemed their thesis suitable for submission.

- The duration of the final examination is expected to be 30 minutes.
- At the beginning of the examination, the student receives two questions from the examination committee. These questions relate to the theoretical and practical aspects of the thesis, and the student has 15 minutes to prepare their answers.
- After the preparation time has elapsed, the student has 10 minutes to present the topic, methodology, and main findings of their thesis.
- During the remaining 20 minutes, the student first answers the two questions posed by the examination committee, followed by a professional discussion with the committee members on further theoretical and practical issues related to the thesis.
